

## **Call for projects**

### **Anthologies and Collection of Essays**

#### **Support Program for the Translation and Publication of Brazilian Authors Abroad**

In order to promote Brazilian essay production and literature, the country's National Library Foundation (FBN) has launched a special call for projects for foreign publishers interested in translating, publishing and distributing abroad anthologies of short-stories and poems as well as collections of essays written by Brazilian authors.

This call for projects is part of the Support Program for the Translation and Publication of Brazilian Authors Abroad, a program formally publicized in the Brazilian Official Gazette (D.O.U.) on August 7<sup>th</sup> 2013, Section 3, Page 20.

The anthologies and collections may include:

- Texts not yet translated into the target language;
- New translations of texts that have already been published to the target language;
- Reprints of previously published texts in the target language;
- Unpublished texts in Brazil, upon discretion of the evaluation committee.

In accordance to the announcement, each selected project will receive a maximum of US\$ 8,000 (eight thousand dollars). All applications must comply with the rules and the criteria established by the announcement of the Support Program for the Translation and Publication of Brazilian Authors Abroad.
